## Alaska's first female bariatric surgeon to join Anchorage Bariatrics

Dr. Orin developed a desire to make an impact on the field of bariatric surgery during a high school exchange program when she stayed with a host family in rural Indiana and watched the host brother struggle with obesity.

"My host brother's inability to access care, the stigma of obesity, and his failed attempts at diet and exercise, opened my eyes to the struggle so many people face," said Dr. Orin.

"Dr. Orin will be an incredible asset to the practice," says Anchorage Bariatrics Practice Manager Kristi Naval, R.N. "We are dedicated to serving the health care needs of our community and look forward to an expanded team that will allow us to keep up with demand."
